



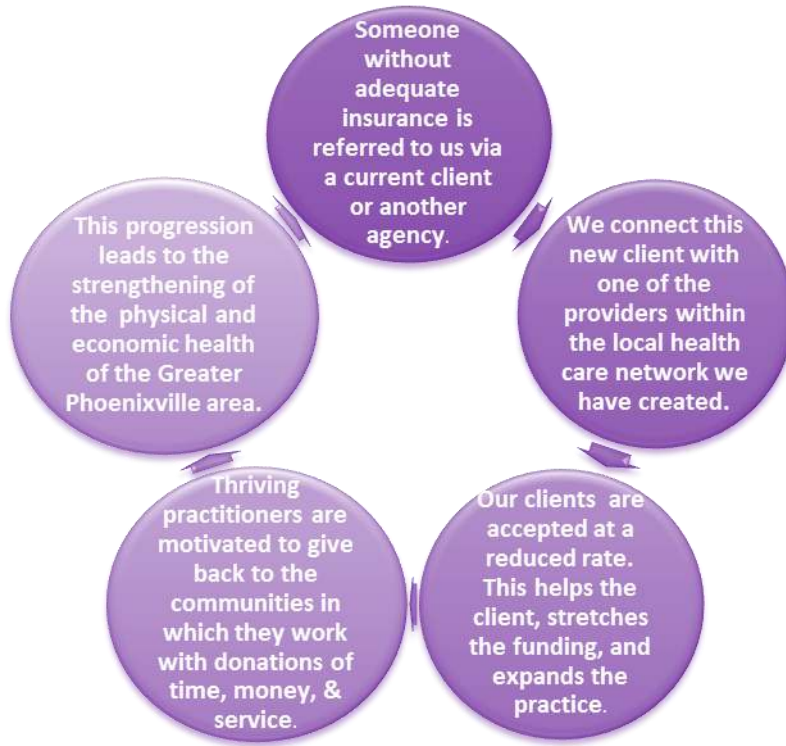

With the added potential for an increase in gifts, we recently equipped ourselves with the fundraising software - DonorPerfect. We now have the ability to track donations

against prior years, and report on our successes.

And please remember, despite the Affordable Care Act, the number of people needing our assistance has not changed. We regularly continue to hear – “what would we have done without your help” from grateful clients.

So spoke Anna Mae Galbraith, long-time HCA Board member and Director of the Phoenixville Hospital Community Health Education & Outreach Department.

Recently, Anna Mae was awarded the March of Dimes Achievement Award for Excellence in the Field of Health. We are very pleased that everyone in Chester County will now know what the hospital has experienced for the last 25 years, and what we at Health Care Access recognized when Anna Mae joined our board ten years ago – Phoenixville is very lucky that this dynamic inspiration has committed her life and her work to the health of the community.

For years, Anna Mae and her hospital team developed outreach programs in response to unmet community needs. In fact, through Mrs. Galbraith’s efforts, a strong partnership developed between Health Care Access, the Hospital, and Community Radiology, to expand the number of screening mammograms offered, and to provide further diagnostic breast studies for uninsured women. We are pleased to report that, in the last three years, HCA has connected 152 women with mammograms. “If we can help people that fall through the cracks, that’s a feel good”, expressed Anna Mae.

Mrs. Galbraith gives credit to some special women in her family for her lasting commitment to helping people. She modeled herself after the “3 G’s” (her mother and her 2 aunts); strong women who gave to their families AND their communities. “The example they set about the difference you can make in life gives me the energy to keep going.” I would also like to thank my husband and children for their support of my work in the community over the years.”



A young girl of six came to us for dental (and vision) care. This child, who is now 14, consistently arranged through HCA to visit the dentist we connected her with twice each year for the last 8 years.

She reported zero cavities for the first five years, only three very small ones the next year, and then no cavities for the last two years. She and Health Care Access together have had this positive impact on her health (and her smile!)

We are also pleased to report that we were able to provide this same client with vision care including five exams and five pairs of glasses.

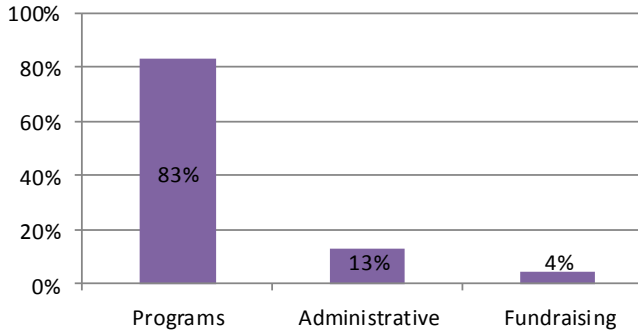

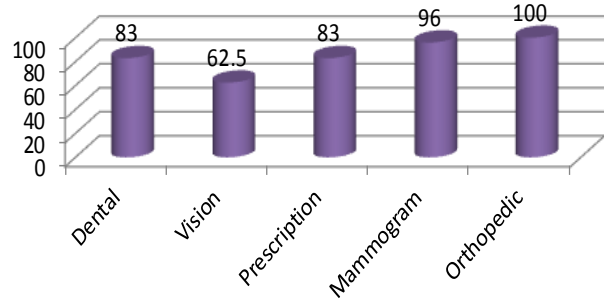

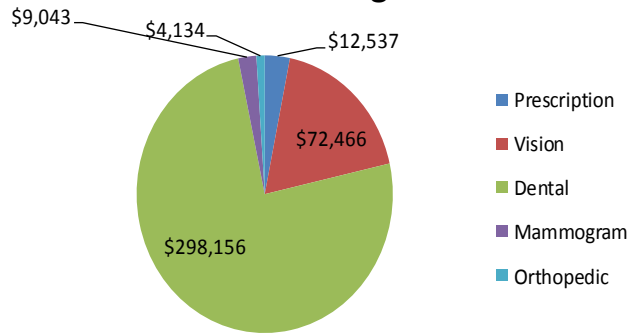
% of FY 2013-14 Total Budget



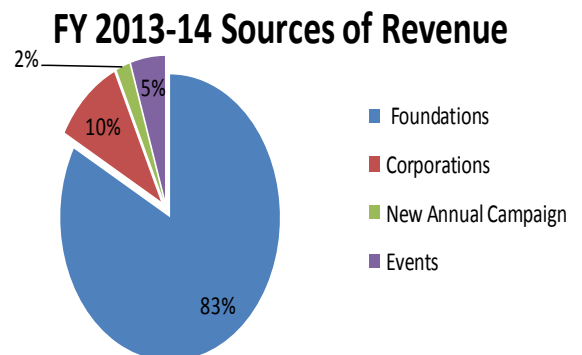
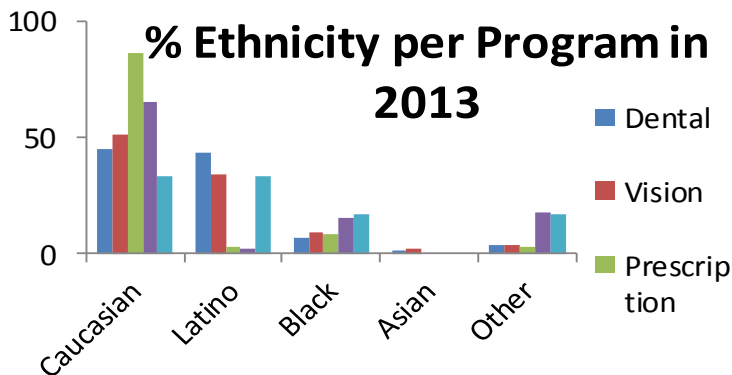
% of Clients without Insurance per Program in 2013

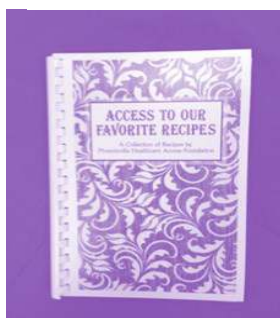
